## **WHAT IS HIGH POWER FOOTBALL?**

High Power Football is an accessible football experience designed to bring the power, strategy, and excitement of American football to life through audio-driven gameplay and vivid Football images and graphics. HPF' is more than a simple football title.

## **HOW AMERICAN FOOTBALL WORKS**

American football is a game of territory, timing, execution, and strategy.

- Two teams battle to score more points than the other team.
- The team with the ball is called the offense.
- The offense tries to move the ball down the field by running or passing.
- The team without the ball is called the defense.
- The defense tries to stop the offense, force mistakes, and take the ball back.
- The offense gets four downs to gain ten yards.
- If the offense gains ten yards, it gets a new set of four downs.
- If it does not, the other team gets possession.
- A touchdown is worth six points.

- A field goal is worth three points.

Football is exciting because every play is a decision.

- Do you run?
- Do you pass?
- Do you play it safe?
- Do you attack deep?

That same football tension lives inside High Power Football. That is why HPF' feels like a Madden-style retro audio football game with real football energy.

### **GETTING STARTED**

To begin your football journey, log into Paschallgamehub.cloud. When the game loads, players are asked if they would like to enter a custom name or coach name. After that, players can enter the stadium by activating the Enter button.

Opening Setup Flow

- Enter your custom name or coach name.
- Enter the stadium.
- Continue to the main HPF splash screen.

This opening setup gives the game a true football-showtime feel, like stepping out of the tunnel and onto the field.

Menu Breakdown

Regular Game/Start New Game

- This option begins a new football journey and opens the game-mode choices, including playing against the computer/AI & our exclusive Multi player mode (head-to-head).

Season Mode

- This is the official HPF 18 game season mode, with 3 pre-season games

Load Saved Game

- This option contains four save slots so players can continue previous progress.

#### Settings

- This option opens the settings menu with accessibility controls, audio settings, and gameplay options.

#### Instructions/How to Play

- This option gives basic instructions for playing the game.
- A more complete game manual is available through the game hub for a full HPF' game breakdown.

#### Edit Profile Name

- This option allows players to change their custom profile name.

#### Leadership Board

- This is the official HPF game leaders across all conferences and divisions

#### Credits

- This option gives acknowledgment to the creators of High Power Football

Players can choose from the following game modes:

#### Regular Game

- Jump into a football matchup and test your skills one game at a time.

#### Season Mode

- Take a team through the full HPF season structure.

Battle through the regular season.

- Fight for playoff position.

Chase the championship.

- Regal Bowl Playoffs

Unleash the chaos.

- Choose any team and take the instant road to the biggest game of them all:

The Regal Crown Bowl.

- Multi Player

This is the live head-to-head mode.

- Compete directly against another player and settle the score on the field.

## **EXPERIENCE LEVELS AND GAME MODES**

### **HPF Rookie**

HPF Rookie has:

- A limited playbook
- No in-game clock
- No time outs
- No heat flashes

This mode is great for learning the game and getting comfortable with controls and play flow.

### **HPF Player**

HPF Player has:

- Extended playbooks
- A 25-second in-game clock for calling plays
- 3-time outs per half
- No heat flash

This mode gives players more football pressure and more strategic control.

### **HPF Professional**

HPF Professional includes everything in HPF Player, plus:

- Advanced AI computer playbook and calling
- The official HPF' Heat Flash System

This is the most intense football mode in the game.

It gives players the full challenge and full power of the HPF experience.

## **THE HPF HEAT FLASH SYSTEM**

The official HPF Heat Flash System rewards great play calling. If your coach calls three consecutive plays for stops or advancement, the game will warn the opposing team or player of the following Heat flash has been activated.

When heat flash is active, the hot team has a strong chance of making an incredible next play.

That next play may result in:

- A very long gain
- A sack
- A fumble

- A turnover
- A touchdown
- A major defensive stop

This system simulates the moment when football teams or players get into the zone.

How to stop a heat flash

The only ways to stop a heat flash are:

- The opposing team must stop any play, which resets the flash back to zero
- The opposing team can call a time out

This makes time outs, game flow, and clock awareness extremely important.

### **HINTS FOR GAME PLAY**

Strong football players do not become predictable. Good strategy means mixing things up and reading the game.

#### **Offensive Strategy Hints**

- Mix up run and pass plays.
- Do not let the defense settle into your habits.
- Use short, medium, and long yardage calls to stay unpredictable.
- Use combination football.
- Pair short runs with medium passes.
- Pair long pass looks with draws, counters, and delay runs.
- Make the defense think before every snap.

#### **Defensive Strategy Hints**

- Watch the habits of the offense.
- If the offense leans on short routes, tighten up underneath.
- If the offense keeps attacking deep, protect the field and force them to earn every yard.
- If the offense keeps running inside, strengthen your front and hit the run lanes.
- If the offense becomes predictable, punish it.

#### **Clock and Momentum Hints**

- Protect your time outs.
- Watch the play clock carefully.
- Watch for momentum swings.
- If the Heat Flash System activates, be ready to stop it quickly.

### **PLAY SELECTION SEQUENCE**

The official play selection sequence in HPF is:

1. Select Run or Pass
2. Select Yards
  - Short

- Medium
  - Long
3. Select Formation
  4. Select Play
  5. Select Target

- DE Left on defense

### Button Two

- WR 2 on offense
- Center on defense

### Button Three

- WR 3 on offense
- DE Right on defense

### Button Four

- WR Slot on offense
- Weak Linebacker on defense

### Button Five

- WR 4 on offense
- Strong Linebacker on defense

### Button Six

- TE on offense
- Strong Safety on defense

### Special access keys for Windows & Desktop users:

- Get instant (Field Report) including game clock, down/yards and more, press (Alt + F)
- Get instant score information, press (Alt + S)
- Turn on/off the built-in narrator, press (Alt + N)
- Mobile users can swipe for up to date & real-time game information

- Bear Front: Pinch
- 4-3 Over: Strong-Side Run Fit

#### Pass Defense

- Base 4-3 / 3-4: Cover 0 Zero-Man Blitz
- Goal Line Match: Man Switch
- Nickel: Cover 1 Robber

- For those craving statistics, all targeted players on offense & defense are custom namable! So go ahead and name yourself as that star Quarterback, receiver or strong linebacker and don't forget to check your game statistics after the game, note, custom player names are savable, so if you don't get to that Regal Crown Bowl on the first try, gather the troops once again for a run.

## **PRESEASON**

Preseason is where players sharpen their skills.

Preseason includes three full games to help players:

- Learn the controls
- Understand team strengths
- Practice football strategy
- Develop comfort with game flow

## **REGULAR SEASON**

The regular season is a tough football grind.

It includes:

- 18 games
- 17 weeks
- 1 bye week for each team

The path to the playoffs is built through:

### **Six Division Games**

- Home-and-away battles against division rivals

### **Four Intra-Conference Games**

- Battles against a rotating division within your conference

### **Four Inter-Conference Games**

- Matchups against a division from the other conference

### **Two More Intra-Conference Games**

- Additional contests against teams from the remaining divisions

## **PLAYOFFS AND THE REGAL CROWN BOWL**

### **Wild Card Round**

- Seeds 2 through 7 in each conference collide
- Six games
- Top seeds receive a bye

### **Divisional Round**

- Wild card winners face the top seeds
- Four games

### **Conference Championship Round**

- The final two teams in each conference fight for the right to advance

### **The Regal Crown Bowl**

- Three rounds.

- Twelve games.
- One champion.
- This is where legends are made.

### **PLAYER POSITIONS**

HPF gives players a clear football identity on both offense and defense with custom namable players/targets.

### **OFFENSIVE SKILL POSITIONS**

- Quarterback
- Half Back / Running Back
- Three Wide Receivers
- One Slot / Multipurpose Receiver
- Tight End

### **DEFENSIVE POSITIONS**

- Defensive End / Left
- Center
- Defensive End / Right
- Weak Linebacker
- Strong Linebacker
- Strong Safety

### **SETTINGS AND ACCESSIBILITY**

The settings area gives players control over their football experience. This section is important for immersion, comfort, and accessibility.

#### **Settings Menu Options**

- Music: On / Off
- Music Volume: Slider control
- Screen Reader: On / Off
- Magnification: Slider to magnify the game window
- Color Contrast: Slider for brightness or darkness
- Game Reset

#### **Built-In Narrator Control**

- The built-in narrator or screen reader can be turned off in the menu.

For Windows users, the access key command is:

- Alt + N
- This turns off the built-in narrator or screen reader.

## **Low Vision Support**

HPF includes support for low vision and vision-impaired players through:

- Magnification
- Color contrast control
- Audio-first gameplay
- Adjustable sound controls

## **In-Game Menu**

During gameplay, the game can be paused to open the in-game menu.

### **For Windows:**

- Press ESC

### **For mobile:**

- Use the in-game menu button

### **The in-game pause menu does not include:**

- Reset Settings
- Game Play Level

## **NAVIGATION FOR WINDOWS AND MOBILE**

HPF is designed to be accessible and easy to move through for players using access technology.

The controls are direct, consistent, and football ready.

## **WINDOWS NAVIGATION**

Windows users can navigate all areas of the game by using:

- Tab
- Directional arrow keys
- Number pad
- Numbers 1 through 6
- The letter B to move through buttons
- Spacebar
- Enter to execute plays

## **MOBILE NAVIGATION**

Mobile users can navigate the game by using:

- Swipe navigation through controls
- Rotor navigation by Buttons
- Double tap to execute plays
- The in-game menu button to pause the action

## **SAVED GAMES, PROFILE EDITING, AND CREDITS**

### Load Saved Game

- Players can store progress in up to four saved game slots.
- This makes it easy to return to the action and continue building a football legacy.

### Edit Profile Name

- Players can change their custom name or coach profile name through the Edit Profile Name option.

### Credits

- The Credits option recognizes the creators and contributors behind High Power Football.
